

## Governor attends groundbreaking ceremony

HUDSON, N.Y. -- Governor David Paterson joined local leaders in Hudson to celebrate the opening of a new low-income housing complex.



Crosswinds at Hudson is a 70-unit apartment complex that was developed by Housing Resources of Columbia County, a not-for-profit that works to create affordable housing. Governor Paterson says this local project can be a model for others around the state.

"We want some people in other area around the state to know that we want to bring the same glee to their neighbors that they brought to Hudson today and since I live so close by, the next time Mayor has a big event in Hudson, give me a ring, I'm right down the block," Paterson said.

The complex features two and three bedroom apartments that rent for between \$565 and \$755 per month. Builders on the project used green construction methods to keep energy consumption down.
